2022 POOL RULES AND REGULATION

1. For the immediate future, the following rules will be in place when the pool opens and will be relaxed as soon as possible:
 - a. The lifeguards have the final say in the amount of people they are comfortable with allowing in the pool.
 - b. Residents and normal memberships only
 1. Homeowner memberships processed online
 2. Homeowners are responsible for their guests using guest passes.
2. Pool admittance requires an approved pool pass online application, and a Zero balance throughout the pool season. Members must provide a picture ID if they have not uploaded a picture with their application.
3. The Pool Management Staff (manager, assistant manager, lifeguards, and entrance attendant) have **absolute authority** for enforcement of all pool rules. The manager and/or assistant manager may deny admission to the pool for a specified length of time for violation of any pool rules.
4. Members under 16 years of age, must be accompanied by an adult.
5. Each household is allowed to bring no more than six (6) guests per day accompanied by an adult member of 18 yrs. of age or older. No one under the age of 18 may bring guests to the pool. All guests must sign in and out of the pool at the desk accompanied by the adult member that is sponsoring them as guests. The **HOST** is responsible for the actions of their guests.
6. Any unauthorized person(s) found inside the pool enclosure without permission either during pool hours or afterhours will lose pool privileges for the remainder of the summer and may be subject to prosecution for trespassing.
7. All persons must take a cleansing shower before entering the pool area, by order of the Frederick County Health Department. All persons entering the pool must be attired in regulation bathing suits...no other attire is permitted.
8. Small floating toys, single air mattresses or the use of face masks, snorkels, swim fins, life rings may be allowed in the pool at designated times and at the discretion of the Pool Management Staff.

9. Emergency equipment and other lifeguard equipment, chairs, etc. are for lifeguard use only. Only authorized personnel are permitted in the pool office, filter equipment rooms and guard stands or behind the check-in desk.
10. No sand chairs or chaises are allowed within five inches (5") of the edge of the pool.
11. Non-toilet trained individuals **MUST** wear approved "swimmer's disposal pants". Failure to adhere to this rule may cause suspension of pool privileges.
12. For the safety of babies and toddlers, children over six (6) are not permitted in the baby pool.
13. Non-swimmers must stay in shallow water (not more than five (5) feet deep). Members unable to swim must be supervised at all times by a swimming responsible adult **WITHIN ARM'S REACH AT ALL TIMES.**
14. The following are **PROHIBITED** on pool grounds:
 - ❖ GLASS OR SHARP METAL OBJECTS
 - ❖ PETS
 - ❖ ABUSIVE, OBSCENE OR ADULT LANGUAGE OR BEHAVIOR
 - ❖ RUNNING, PUSHING, SPLASHING, UNRULY BEHAVIOR
 - ❖ SOUND OF ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT
 - ❖ WHEELED VEHICLES EXCEPT BABY CARRIAGES, STROLLERS OR WHEEL CHAIRS
 - ❖ PLAYING, SWINGING OR DIVING OVER THE FLOAT LINES
 - ❖ CLIMBING, HANGING OR PLAYING ON GUARD CHAIRS
 - ❖ CHEWING GUM OR TOBACCO
 - ❖ USE OF ANY TOBACCO PRODUCTS OR SMOKING
 - ❖ ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OF ANY KIND....Pool Management reserves the right to inspect any container and refuse entry if alcoholic beverages are found or suspected. **USE OF ALCOHOL BEVERAGES** will result in suspension of Pool Privileges.
 - ❖ PERSONS WEARING ANY BANDAGES AND/OR WITH SKIN ABRASIONS, COLDS, INFLAMED EYES, OR OTHER TYPES OF POSSIBLY CONTAGIOUS INFECTIONS
15. The following are **PROHIBITED** except in designated areas:
 - ❖ Snacks
 - ❖ BEVERAGES IN CAN AND PLASTIC CONTAINERS
16. The Pool Management Staff shall have the absolute authority to immediately suspend the pool privileges of any member for any of the following reasons.

- ❖ Nudity (except within normal use of the locker room facility) Lewd, obscene, indecent behavior (in the pool or locker room facility)
- ❖ Behavior which is considered unsanitary or offensive will result in loss of pool privileges.

17. Diving allowed in the “Diving Well” only with use of Diving Board only. NO SWIMMING OR GAMES ALLOWED IN THE DIVING WELL. Rules of Diving Board:

- No non-swimmers allowed in the diving well
- Only one diver is permitted on the board at a time
- Diving is permitted from the end of the board only
- Exit diving well immediately after diving
- Wait until preceding diver swims clear of diving well before diving
- No diving off sides of pool
- Pool staff will test the ability of any swimmer wishing to use the diving area
- No hanging on the diving board

18. The pool may be closed at the discretion of the Pool Manager in compliance with county or health department code, operational breakdown or weather conditions.

19. Ten (10) minute rest periods will be announced every hour. During the rest periods, only lap lane swimming is allowed.

20. Management reserves the right to change any pool rules when necessary. Additional rules may be posted within the pool house and must be followed by all homeowners and guests.
