DESTRUCTION OF COMMUNITY PROPERTY

During the months of December and January, we have had someone causing destruction to the trees in the Taskers Common Ground areas. Unfortunately, the culprits have been sawing and breaking branches off of very large mature trees causing some major damage. All of the trees that have been attacked are along Key Parkway behind Greensprings and along Baughman Lane behind The Estates. This is malicious acts of destruction. TREATMENT OF ROADS DURING SNOW AND ICE STORMS

I have received several emails concerning the promptness of snow removal and spreading of salt on our Community Roads. Remember, the Community roads are owned and operated by the City; therefore, any snow removal or salt treatments are controlled by the City. As to the City time table, they do treat roads according to importance. Any snow emergency routes will be treated first, any further major roadways will be treated next and Community secondary roads are treated when

their schedule allows. If you feel that the roads have not been treated in due time, contact the DPW of the City of Frederick with your concerns.

NO PARKING ISSUES WITHIN TASKERS

We held a meeting with the City Traffic Engineer and other officials from the City of Frederick over the issue of the new No Parking Signs and restrictions. Apparently, the no parking will continue to be in force. The specific areas that were discussed at the meeting will be reviewed to see if any changes can take place. Otherwise, parking is as is noted by the signage. Basically, no parking within the cul-de-sacs, and no parking on the sides of each street with the posted signs. Another words, for instance, Lindfield Drive has parking only on the Eastern side of the street...no parking is allowed on the western side. It was interesting that the guidelines for measurement of streets for initiating the no parking restrictions was mandated by the State of Maryland, not by the City of Frederick. The minimum street width restrictions is for the health and safety of the residents of the Community. Further information shared was that not only were the state mandated widths considered but they also received feedback on the issue from the Department of Public Works and from the Fire and Rescue Division heads. Again, these new restrictions are effecting other Communities within the City of Frederick as well, not just Taskers.

TRASH ISSUES IN OUR COMMUNITY

Please be sure to keep your trash cans covered. We have received many complaints recently for varmint infestation concerns.

Trash cans and Recycle bins can not be in view of the street according to Community guidelines. Therefore, all cans must be completely out of sight of the main street. If you wish for your cans to be located to the side of your home, you must have dense plantings around them to obscure them from view; otherwise, they must be stored behind your homes, in your garages, or behind your privacy fencing.

Those using trash corrals, please respect your fellow neighbors, put your trash inside a can and replace the lid. NO BULK TRASH OR RECYCLE can be placed inside of trash corrals.

Taskers View sub-division, the HOA will be visiting your Community, door to door, in the near future to discuss trash options that the City wishes to be considered.
