City of Frederick Offers Bulk Trash Roundup

FREDERICK, MD – March 21, 2017: The next bulk trash Freecycle Roundup serving The City of Frederick will be Saturday, April 22.

The Freecycle Roundup, where bulk trash and reusable goods are collected and separated, will operate 8 a.m.-2 p.m, April 22, at the Public Works facility, 111, Airport Drive East.

Notes about Freecycle Roundup:

1. For Frederick City residents only; they will need to bring identification that is proof of residency
2. Bulk items only; no bags of trash
3. Document shredding will be available
4. What can be dropped off
 - furniture, appliances – if all refrigerants are removed
 - box springs and mattresses – no more than three of each per household, must sign affidavit
 - exercise equipment
 - grills with fuel tanks removed
 - large televisions
5. For those unable to bring their items to the site, limited pickup is available by appointment only. To request pickup, contact and confirm with Renee Greer at 301-600-6990, by April 10. Pickups are arranged and conducted by the Frederick Community Action Agency's Green Jobs Team.

The city organizes the Freecycle Roundup semiannually to residents so they can dispose of bulk trash, and reusable items can be removed from the waste stream.
